4		rate at the Sells Service Unit; and						
5	WHEREAS,	the numbers of prescriptions filled by the Sells Service Unit have increased by 60%						
6		since more patients keep appointments due to diabetic complications and increased						
7		availability of clinics; and						
8	WHEREAS,	complications, specifically diabetes has increased by 100% in the past several years;						
9		and						
10	WHEREAS,	complication related prescriptions for high cholesterol, glaucoma and dialysis are						
11		more frequently prescribed adding to a patient's longevity and increasing cost; and						
12	WHEREAS,	studies have proven that proper care and medications save money in the long term						
13		because of decreased complications and hospital stays; and						
14	WHEREAS,	the Sells Service Unit is in need of funds for appropriate diabetes medication in						
15		order to continue to provide the Tohono O'odham Nation with quality care for						
16		Tohono O'odham diabetics.						
17	NOW, THER	, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does						
18		request that Congress appropriate \$145,000.00 to treat diabetes and its						
19		complications.

21		to bring this request to the appropriate Agencies, Members and Committees of
