

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
(Authorizing Transfer of Funds to the Environmental Trust Fund)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-149

1 **WHEREAS, there is a need for initial funding of the Environmental Trust Fund which was**  
2 **established by the Solid Waste Management Code, to enable the Tohono O'odham**  
3 **Nation to respond promptly to environmental contamination incidents and natural**  
4 **disasters; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Investment Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee recommend**  
6 **transferring Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) from the IC007 account**  
7 **to the Environmental Trust Fund.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes**  
9 **and directs the Chairman of the Nation and his staff to transfer Two Hundred**  
10 **Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) from the IC007 account to the Environmental Trust**  
11 **Fund for use in response to environmental contamination incidents and natural**  
12 **disasters.**

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14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD.**  
15 **Day of APRIL, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,575.2 FOR; 222.6**  
16 **AGAINST; 367.7 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
17 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
18 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
19 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
20 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


