

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating and Authorizing Expenditure of Funds to Support Economic
Development Activities for O'odham in Mexico)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-150

- 1 **WHEREAS, Initiative IN-01-97 authorized certain economic development programs, including**
2 **the Business Grant program, business education activities, support for individual**
3 **business owners, and economic development planning; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, this Initiative also authorized expenditure of gaming funds in support of these**
5 **activities; and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch submitted a budget and scope of work for the Economic**
7 **Development Department to conduct these as program activities during FY 2000; and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, Legislative Council, by means of Resolution 99-359, approved the budget and scope**
9 **of work for the Economic Development Department and appropriated funds from**
10 **Gaming Savings to support the budget; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, the approved budget and scope of work were for delivery of service from the**
12 **program's offices on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, members of the Tohono O'odham Nation living in Mexico have expressed their desire**
14 **to participate in and benefit from these program activities; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, delivery of services to O'odham in Mexico will require outreach to the People in their**
16 **area of residence, new programs materials, and additional services from attorneys,**
17 **translators, and business consultants; and**
- 18 **WHEREAS, the Economic Development Department has submitted a budget and scope of work**
19 **for a project to investigate alternative ways the program might provide economic**
20 **development services to O'odham in Mexico.**
- 21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
22 **that the budget and scope of work submitted by the Economic Development**
23 **Department for a project to investigate service delivery in Mexico are approved.**
- 24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation to enter into contracts and agreements in support of these activities.**
- 26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$175,000.00 are appropriated from the**
27 **Desert Diamond Savings Account.**

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1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Council authorizes transfer of these funds to the Initiative
2 **Administrative Cost Account, and authorizes their expenditure from this account as**
3 **part of the overall budget for the Economic Development Department.**

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5 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD.**
6 **Day of APRIL, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,902.6 FOR; -0-**
7 **AGAINST; 262.9 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
8 **Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
9 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
10 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
11 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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
