

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Intern Program Budget for the Schuk Toak Farm)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-155

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 awards to the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Nation 10,800 acre feet of CAP Water and 5,200 acre feet of additional water**
3 **suitable for agriculture for delivery to the Schuk Toak District to settle damages by**
4 **that portion of the district; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District has always been interested in the opportunities that the**
6 **Schuk Toak Farm will bring; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, one of the opportunities afforded to the Schuk Toak District is employment and in**
8 **order to fulfil this opportunity training for Schuk Toak District members is**
9 **necessary; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak Farm will be ready for operation in the very near future and**
11 **employees will be needed to fill positions at the Schuk Toak Farm; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council did enact Resolution No. ST-02-02-00-07 (Approval**
13 **and Support of Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Management Board to Obtain**
14 **Funding from SAWRSA Trust Funds for Schuk Toak Farm Programs); and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council did also enact Resolution No.: ST-03-09-00-08**
16 **(Approval and Support of the Intern Program Budget for the Schuk Toak Farm); and**
- 17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did on February 10, 1999, by Resolution No.**
18 **99-060, approve and adopt the Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono**
19 **O'odham Farming Authority; and**
- 20 **WHEREAS, according to the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority's Second Restated Plan of**
21 **Operation Section 3.1.3 to provide business training and employment opportunities**
22 **for members of the Tohono O'odham Nation consistent with the purposes expressed**
23 **in this Plan of Operation; and**
- 24 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Board and Management did present to the**
25 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council the Budget for the Intern Program in the**
26 **amount of \$453,690.72.**
- 27 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does**
28 **hereby approve the Intern Program Budget for the Schuk Toak Farm attached**

2 SAWRSA Trust fund in the amount of \$453,690.72.

4 Tohono O'odham Farming Authority, the Executive Office and other departments to
5 execute necessary documents and process funds to be deposited into the Tohono
6 O'odham Farming Authority's account at Bank of America for the Intern Program
7 budget for the Schuk Toak Farms.


8 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH
9 Day of APRIL, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,877.4 FOR; -0-
10 AGAINST; 128.1 NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
11 by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
12 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
13 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
14 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
