

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Schuk Toak Farm Working Capital Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-156

1 **WHEREAS, the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 awards to the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Nation 10,800 acre feet of CAP Water and 5,200 acre feet of additional water**
3 **suitable for agriculture for delivery to the Schuk Toak District to settle damages by**
4 **that portion of the district; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the District participated in the planning efforts to determine the use of the water**
6 **supply and decided to utilize the CAP portion to serve a new farm located on the**
7 **Garcia Strip; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council enacted Resolution No. ST-02-02-00-06 (Approval and**
9 **Support of the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Management Board to Manage**
10 **and Operate the Schuk Toak District Farm); and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Farm will be ready for operation in the very near future; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council also enacted Resolution No. ST-02-02-00-07**
13 **(Approval and Support of Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Management Board**
14 **to Obtain Funding from SAWRSA Trust Funds for Schuk Toak Farm Programs); and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Board and Management did present to the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council the Working Capital Budget for the Schuk Toak**
17 **Farm in the amount of \$10,057,176.00 for over a four year period; and**

18 **WHEREAS, funding for the Working Capital Budget for Schuk Toak Farm will come out of the**
19 **SAWRSA Trust Fund.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does**
21 **hereby approve the Schuk Toak Farm Working Capital Budget in the amount of**
22 **\$10,057,176.00 for over a four year period and that funding for this come out of the**
23 **SAWRSA Trust Funds.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
25 **Tohono O'odham Farming Authority, the Executive Office and other departments to**
26 **execute necessary documents and process funds to be deposited into the Tohono**
27 **O'odham Farming Authority's account at Bank of America.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority Management Board will**

1 provide expenditure reports on these funds at the end of each year to the Tohono
2 O'odham Legislative Council.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH.
4 Day of APRIL, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,769.65 FOR; -0-
5 AGAINST; 235.85 NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
6 by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
7 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
9 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


