

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Cancellation of May 08 & 09, 2000 Enrollment Final Determination Hearings)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 2000-170**

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to section "(1)" of the Rules of Procedure for Hearings on Final  
2 Determination of Eligibility for Enrollment or Adoption ("Rules"), the Chairman of  
3 the Legislative Council in consultation with the Enrollment Committee scheduled  
4 hearings for May 08 & 09, 2000; and

5 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee, Enrollment Committee, Vice Chairman and Chairman of the  
6 Legislative Council have identified a need to revise section "(18)" of the Rules before  
7 the Legislative Council holds further enrollment final determination hearings; and

8 WHEREAS, it is not possible to prepare and serve the "enrollment rejection packets" as  
9 required by section "(14) (a)" of the Rules for May 08 & 09, 2000.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL THAT  
11 THE:

- 12 1. May 08 & 09, 2000 enrollment final determination hearings are canceled and are  
13 to be rescheduled pursuant to section "(1)" of the Rules; and
- 14 2. Enrollment Office shall notify the May 08 & 09, 2000 applicants of the  
15 cancellation; and
- 16 3. Rules Committee shall consider, recommend and propose revisions including  
17 but not limited to section "(18)" of the Rules; and
- 18 4. Enrollment Committee provide an update on the Enrollment Final  
19 Determination Hearings at the May 2000 General Session.

20 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH  
21 Day of APRIL, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR; -0-  
22 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 128.1[06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
23 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
24 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
26 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
