

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Justice Information
User Agreement)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-184

- 1 **WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Tohono O'odham Constitution provides that the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Legislative Council has the power "To consult, negotiate and conclude**
3 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal,**
4 **State and local governments..."; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 1 of the Tohono O'odham Constitution provides that, "The**
6 **judicial power of the Tohono O'odham Nation Shall be vested in the Tohono O'odham**
7 **Judiciary..." Further, Article VIII, Section 5 of the Tohono O'odham Constitution**
8 **provides that the Chief Judge shall be the "chief administrative officer of the Tohono**
9 **O'odham Judiciary..."; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, in order to insure that the constitutionally assigned tasks of the Judiciary will be**
11 **performed properly, it is necessary that the Judiciary establish employment**
12 **standards for its employees; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Judiciary has adopted job descriptions for all positions of**
14 **employment within the Judiciary. These job descriptions have been approved by the**
15 **chief judge, and contain pre-requisites for employment with the Judiciary; and**
- 16 **WHEREAS, one of the pre-requisites for employment with the Tohono O'odham Judiciary is that**
17 **a criminal history background check shall be completed regarding each applicant**
18 **to ensure the applicant's suitability for Judiciary employment; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Public Safety maintains an information access system**
20 **which authorizes access to criminal history information for criminal justice**
21 **purposes; and**
- 22 **WHEREAS, execution of an Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Justice Information**
23 **User Agreement by the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Arizona Department of**
24 **Public Safety is necessary in order that the Tohono O'odham Judiciary may receive**
25 **access to the requested criminal history information; and**
- 26 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee of the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
27 **has reviewed the Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Justice Information**
28 **User Agreement and recommends its approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation
2 that it approves the Arizona Department of Public Safety Criminal Justice
3 Information User Agreement and directs the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham
4 Nation to execute said Agreement for the benefit of the Tohono O'odham Judiciary.

5 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST.
6 Day of MAY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,521.4 FOR; 644.1
7 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
8 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
9 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
11 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


