

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of Higher Education Services FY-2000, Budget Mod. #2 Acct. # 10-1215)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-185

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Higher Education Services program has**
2 **been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post-Secondary Institutes; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services has a final allocation reduction for FY-2000, in the**
5 **amount of \$4,622.00; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the FY-2000 Higher Education Services budget modification also reflects reducing**
7 **line items to reflect the reduction.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the**
9 **Higher Education Services budget modification #2 reflecting the FY-2000 final**
10 **allocation in the amount of \$854,578.69.**

11 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01ST.**
12 **Day of MAY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,079.6 FOR; -0-**
13 **AGAINST; 85.9 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
14 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
15 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
16 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
17 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


