

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Donating \$51,300 to A'al We:pek/Children First, Inc. for workshops and training)**

**DEFEATED
RESOLUTION NO. 2000-189**

1 **WHEREAS, A'al We:pek/Children First, Inc. is a drug and alcohol prevention non-profit**
2 **organization serving the children and families of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the children of the Nation are valuable resources of the future; and**
4 **WHEREAS, in order to preserve this valuable resource, adults need the opportunity to heal in**
5 **order to be healthy role models to the children; and**
6 **WHEREAS, monies received from Legislative Council will be utilized for training current staff of**
7 **A'al We:pek/Children First, Inc.; and**
8 **WHEREAS, workshops will be possible for members of the Nation who are willing to participate**
9 **in investing their time and efforts in the prevention of substance abuse among the**
10 **children of the Nation.**
11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
12 **donation of \$51,300 to the A'al We:pek/Children First, Inc. for workshops and**
13 **training.**
14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$51,300 will be appropriated from the**
15 **General Revenue Fund.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 02ND.**
18 **Day of MAY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote of 1,056.4 FOR; 1,109.1**
19 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of**
20 **the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation.**
