1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution Nos. 97-451 and 97-452 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Counci
2		adopted a Funding Implementation Plan and a Revenue Allocation Plan (collectively
3		the "Plans") to implement the disbursement of per capita payments to eligible
4		members of the Tohono O'odham Nation, as authorized by Initiative No. IN-01-97
5		and
6	WHEREAS,	with the exception of biennial per capita payments, the Plans were approved by the
7		Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") in a letter dated December 18, 1997; and
8	WHEREAS,	certain amendments to the Plans are required to (1) facilitate the negotiation of an
9		agreement with a reputable financial institution to establish and administer
10		investment accounts into which the per capita payments for minor eligible members
11		would be deposited; and (2) authorize the Legislative Council, in its discretion, to
12		supplement the per capita payment to each eligible member, who was a minor for
13		any period on and after December 26, 1997, with accrued earnings realized in the per
14		capita set-aside account maintained pursuant to the Funding Implementation Plan
15	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
16	1	1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves Amendment No. 1 to the
17		Funding Implementation Plan, in the form attached hereto.
18		2. The Legislative Council approves Amendment No. 1 to the Revenue Allocation
19		Plan, in the form attached hereto.
20		3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to submit each
21		Amendment to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for approval.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>02ND</u>. day of MAY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
