(Approving the Request for Appropriation for the Renovation and Construction of New Head Start/Child Care Centers on the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-201

1	WHEREAS,	the Division of Early Childhood Development operates Head Start center-based
2		programs for children ages 3 to 5 years of age at centers located in Santa Rosa,
3		Pisinemo, Vaya Chin, San Lucy, San Xavier, Sif Oidak and Sells; and
4	WHEREAS,	the Division also operates child care center-based services for children ages 6
5		months - 3 years at the Sells and San Xavier centers; and
6	WHEREAS,	these services are designed primarily to provide child care and preschool
7		educational services for families who are income eligible, pursuing training or
8		employment or have children with special needs; and
9	WHEREAS,	the eligible population includes those families who are categorized as the most in
10		need of services; and
11	WHEREAS,	both Head Start and Child Care have also made every effort to provide services to
12		families whose parents work full-time, realizing the importance of assisting these
13		families in maintaining their self-sufficiency; and
14	WHEREAS,	it is known that the existing structures for all center-based programs are in dire
15		need of immediate replacement, some of which are over twenty-years old; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has undergone on-site monitoring visits and
17		inspections from the American Indian Head Start Bureau and Indian Health
18		Services - Environmental Health Offices. Both of these agencies found the existing
19		facilities to have critical violations based on health and safety requirements; and
20	WHEREAS,	the O'odham Education Department has prepared a request for appropriation
21		which includes the construction of new Head Start/Child Care Centers in Santa
22		Rosa, Vaya Chin, Pisinemo, Sif Oidak, Gu Vo, and Sells; and
23	WHEREAS,	the request for appropriation also includes funding for the renovation of the
24		existing centers in San Lucy and San Xavier; and
25	WHEREAS,	the department has made presentations and consulted with all eleven districts of
26		the Tohono O'odham Nation and, to date, has received resolutions from eight of the
27		11 districts along with support to proceed from the remaining districts; and

(Approving the Request for Appropriation for the Renovation and Construction of New Head Start/Child Care Centers on the Tohono O'odham Nation) Page 2 of 4 WHEREAS, the department has prepared budgets for each component of the request which 1 2 include program administration budgets and the actual project budget which 3 provides funds for construction, renovation, capital equipment, office & 4 communication equipment, professional services and contingencies for the entire 5 project; and 6 WHEREAS, the request for appropriation totals \$8,192,697.00 to be taken from the Tohono 7 O'odham Nation's Savings from Gaming Revenues; and 8 WHEREAS, it is also understood that the request for appropriation does not include funding for 9 long-term repair and maintenance nor does it include increased costs associated 10 with staffing, utilities or other related expenses; and 11 WHEREAS, the Division of Early Childhood Development along with the Nation's Facilities 12 Management Program will prepare budgets for review and approval during fiscal 13 year 2001 and 2002 in preparation for any such unmet financial needs. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby 14 15 supports and approves the O'odham Education Department's Request for 16 Appropriation for the Renovation and Construction of Head Start/Child Care **17** Centers. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby appropriates 19 the sum of \$8,192,697.00 from the Tohono O'odham Nation's Savings from Gaming 20 Revenues to be used in a multi-year capital project pursuant to approved budgets. 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council directs that the 22 \$8,192,697.00 be deposited in a segregated, interest-bearing account to be used 23 exclusively for the renovation and construction of Head Start/Child Care Centers as 24 described herein. 25 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the 26 Chairman and any officials, to wit, to negotiate and execute any and all contracts in 27 order to ensure project completion, it further authorizes the Chairman and the 28 Treasurer to proceed and investigate the placement of a Bond Obligation.
