1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has approved a Wellness Budget for Youth and Elders**
2 **for activities; and**


3 **WHEREAS, due to no additional availability of funds from other budgets currently being**
4 **expended by the Senior Services Division; and**

5 **WHEREAS, a budget modification has been submitted which does not change the funding level**
6 **but adds new line items and increases and decreases current line items to fund the**
7 **Staff Retreat.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wellness Budget for fiscal year 2000 is hereby**
9 **approved as presented and is authorized to be expended accordingly.**

11 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH,**
12 **Day of MAY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,438.0 FOR; 727.5**
13 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
14 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
15 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
16 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
17 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


