

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(BIA/Tribal Budget System Priority Ranking for FY 2002)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-209**

1 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Papago Agency presented to the Tohono O'odham**  
2 **Legislative Council the projected FY 2002 Planning Base Amounts under the Tribal**  
3 **Priority Allocations of the Bureau Budget for FY 2002; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Papago Agency submitted the Tribal Priority Allocation programs and funding**  
5 **allocation levels for contracted programs under Budget B, and the unmet needs**  
6 **forms for Budget C, and narrative justification statements forms from both budgets**  
7 **to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the priority rankings provide the Tohono O'odham Nation the opportunity to**  
9 **participate in the Federal Budget Formulation process for the allocation and**  
10 **ranking resources available under the Tribal Priority Allocations budget category;**  
11 **and**

12 **WHEREAS, the rankings depict the Nation's priorities as previously established; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the proposed FY 2002**  
14 **Budgets B and C and justifications for P.L. 93-638 contracted programs and Priority**  
15 **Ranking Numbers as submitted by the Executive Office; and Budget C and**  
16 **justifications for Agency operated programs and Priority Ranking Numbers as**  
17 **submitted by Papago Agency.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**  
19 **Projected Planning Base Amounts and Rankings under Budgets B and C of the**  
20 **Bureau budget be adopted for FY 2002.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the following**  
22 **Top Ten (10) Priority Ranking be adopted for FY 2002 for the P.L. 93-638 contracted**  
23 **programs:**

- 24 **1. Services to Children, Elderly, Families (Human Services)**
- 25 **2. Law Enforcement Services/Ranger Program**
- 26 **3. Tribal Courts**
- 27 **4. Scholarships**
- 28 **5. Adult Vocational Training**


