

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Cold Fields Community/Baboquivari District FY-00 Supplement
Budget Amendment/Modification)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-213

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 99-109, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
2 **Baboquivari District FY-99 Supplement budget; and**

3 **WHEREAS, any change in the justifications or funding levels, need Tohono O'odham Legislative**
4 **Council review and approval; and**

5 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 00-B-23, the Baboquivari District Council approved amendments**
6 **and modifications for Coldfields Community; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council was presented with Coldfields**
8 **Community's budget amendments in the following line items:**

9 **724.32 Supplies - Kitchen - Kitchen utensils and small appliances of less than**
10 **\$200.00; ETC.**

11 **759.32 Other Equipment - Any single item in excess of \$200.00 but less than**
12 **\$5,000.00; carts, shelvings; bookshelves; bulletproof vests; and tools; folding**
13 **chairs; tables; speakers; microphones; electrical cords; extension cords;**
14 **security lights; step ladders; overalls; goggles; gloves; drop in lights/lamps;**
15 **folding table truck; folding chair truck; etc.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
17 **approves the Coldfields Community/Baboquivari District FY-00 Supplement**
18 **amendment and budget modification in the amount of \$16,000.00 (Sixteen thousand**
19 **dollars and no cents) to be distributed to the aforementioned line items.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amendments will be incorporated into the current FY-00**
21 **Supplement Budget.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH**
23 **Day of MAY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






