

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Establishing the Livestock Facility Program within the Natural Resources Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-239

1   **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility Program is under the direction of the Natural Resources**  
2                   **Department; and**

3   **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Program has been responsible for maintaining the use of the**  
4                   **facilities; and**

5   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Natural Resources Department FY 2000 budget**  
6                   **establishes funds for the Livestock Facility staff consisting of the Livestock Facility**  
7                   **Manager and Secretary who are full time employees of the Tohono O'odham Nation;**  
8                   **and**

9   **WHEREAS, the mission of the Livestock Facility is to oversee the Tohono O'odham Nation's cattle**  
10                  **industry; to inform and assist the livestock ranchers on how to properly manage and**  
11                  **develop the Nation's range lands and to sell alfalfa hay from the Nation's farms to the**  
12                  **public at lowered costs; and**

13   **WHEREAS, establishment of programs to manage the Livestock Facility under the Natural**  
14                  **Resources Department is to provide a center for complete animal protection, care,**  
15                  **and marketing for the livestock on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

16   **WHEREAS, the Livestock Facility is also intended to serve as center for the training and**  
17                  **education of cattlemen and youth in all areas of ranching and livestock handling;**  
18                  **and**

19   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Livestock Facility has developed a Plan of Operations that will**  
20                  **be utilized in the operation of the facility for the benefit of the Nation and its**  
21                  **members; and**

22   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Livestock Facility had also developed and implemented**  
23                  **policies and procedures for the use of the complex and the facilities.**

24   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

25                   **1. Establishment of the Livestock Facility Program with the Natural Resources**  
26                   **Department in the form of the proposal hereto is hereby approved.**

27                   **2. The Livestock Facility Program Plan of Operations is approved and the Chairman**  
28                   **of the Nation is authorized and directed to implement the Livestock Facility**  
29                   **Program as described therein.**

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- 3. The Livestock Facility Program is approved for a special account for revenue deposit from pen proceeds. Assistance from the Accounting Department will be needed to set up this account.
- 4. The Livestock Facility Program will provide to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members a safe and useful center for complete animal protection, care and marketing.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day of JUNE, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,037.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 128.1 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) & (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
