

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Donating \$56,300 to A'al We:pek/Children First Inc. for workshops and training of staff)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-241

1 WHEREAS, A'al We:pek/Children First Inc., is a drug and alcohol prevention non-profit  
2 organization serving the children and families of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and  
3 WHEREAS, the children of the Nation are valuable resources of the future; and  
4 WHEREAS, in order to preserve this valuable resource, adults need the opportunity to heal in  
5 order to be healthy role models to the children; and  
6 WHEREAS, monies received will be utilized for training current staff; and  
7 WHEREAS, workshops will be possible for members of the Nation who are willing to participate  
8 in investing their time and efforts in breaking the cycle of substance abuse among  
9 the O'odham.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the  
11 donation of \$56,300 to A'al We:pek/Children First, Inc. for workshops and training  
12 of staff.


13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH.

15 AGAINST; 80.0 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
16 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
17 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
19 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




