

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution #99-204, "Approval of the Livestock Complex to set up a
Special Account for the Deposit of Generated Hay Revenues")

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-242

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council approved Resolution Number 99-**
2 **204 approving the Livestock Complex to set up a special account for the Deposit of**
3 **Generated Hay Sales; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority has agreed to provide wholesale hay to the**
5 **Livestock Complex for retail sale. This will provide the logistic demand of equal**
6 **distribution and access for the purchase of hay; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Complex is seeking ways and means to establish the Livestock Complex**
8 **to its original intent and use; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Livestock Complex is seeking additional means of funding its operation by**
10 **generating revenues through the sale of alfalfa hay; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the sale of the alfalfa hay from the Nation's farming provides a community**
12 **commodity to the Livestock owners. This, in turn, keeps the income and revenues**
13 **on the reservation and aiding efforts towards enhancing the Nation's economic base.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Livestock Complex be approved for a special fund**
15 **from hay proceeds.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:**

17 1. **The Accounting Department is authorized to establish a special revenue fund for**
18 **the purpose of receiving and distributing revenue from the retail sale of alfalfa**
19 **hay produced by the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority. If not available from**
20 **the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority, other Nation's sources may be**
21 **considered. If not available from Nation's Farms, other outside vendors may be**
22 **considered.**

23 2. **The Comptroller is directed to assign a revenue account number to the Livestock**
24 **Complex Program.**

25 3. **The Livestock Complex Program is authorized to expend funds in the revenue**
26 **fund for the following purposes;**

27 a) **to pay for the alfalfa hay sold; and**

28 b) **to fund the Livestock Yard Attendant position; and**

29 c) **to fund the service, maintenance and upgrade of the Livestock Complex and**
30 **Complex equipment.**

4. The Livestock Facility Manager is required to submit quarterly reports to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Oversight Committee.
