

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham Nation Request for Membership in the Native American
Fish and Wildlife Society)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-243

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, a federally recognized Indian Tribe located in south-**
2 **central Arizona, desires to promote the protection and preservation of its natural**
3 **resources through proper management for the use of its members and future**
4 **generations; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Native American Fish & Wildlife Society (NAFWS) has been in existence since 1983**
6 **and has an established national office to assist the tribes in:**

- 7 **1. Establishing new fish and wildlife programs; and**
- 8 **2. Supporting funding for tribal fish and wildlife programs; and**
- 9 **3. Educating and training Indian fish and wildlife biologists, managers, technicians**
10 **and conservation officers; and**
- 11 **4. Representing future tribal fish and wildlife needs through the Congressional**
12 **process; and**
- 13 **5. Promoting tribal management capabilities on a national level through an**
14 **exchange of information via newsletters, technical bulletins, other pertinent**
15 **information as well as regional training/workshops; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation fully supports the efforts and activities of the Native**
17 **American Fish & Wildlife Society as stated above; and**

18 **WHEREAS, in order to benefit from the above listed services, a membership in the NAFWS is**
19 **required.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 21 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation hereby wishes to become a member of the Native**
22 **American Fish and Wildlife Society and participate in the services provided by**
23 **the organization and its staff.**
- 24 **2. This Resolution of Support shall be submitted to the NAFWS.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH,**
27 **Day of JUNE, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (I) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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


