RESOLUTION NO. 2000-257

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services is presently operating the
2 Administrative Support Unit through approved Tribal funding; and

3 WHEREAS, a budget modification/amendment has been submitted which does not change the
4 funding level but includes reclassification of a Building & Grounds worker position
5 to Administrative Assistant position, establishes one new line item and modifies
6 other line items.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
8 approves the attached FY 2000 Administrative Support Unit Budget Modification
9 #1/Amendment #1 as reflected in the attached budget.

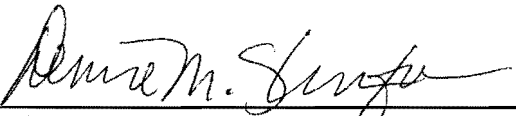

16 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
17 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

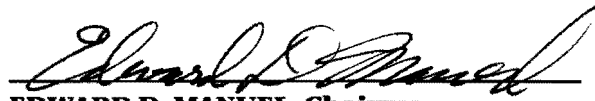
