

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Transferring the Management of the Water Projects Office from the Executive Branch of
Government of the Tohono O'odham Nation to the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-267

1 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office is a Program of the Executive Branch of the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Nation supervised directly by the Chairman of the Nation; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the specific purpose of the Water Projects Office is to design and develop the Schuk**
4 **Toak New Farm and transfer the operation and management to the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Farming Authority; and**
6 **WHEREAS, the federally-funded development phase of the Schuk Toak New Farm Project is near**
7 **completion; and**
8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority is competent and willing to assume**
9 **supervision of the Water Projects Office activities and staff in order to ensure a**
10 **smooth integration of activities and orderly transition to management of the Schuk**
11 **Toak Farm by the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:**

- 13 1. **Effective on June 12, 2000 the Executive Branch Program known as the Water**
14 **Projects Office shall cease to be supervised by the Chairman of the Tohono**
15 **O'odham Nation and shall become an activity wholly controlled by the Board of**
16 **Directors and managed by senior management officials of the Tohono O'odham**
17 **Farming Authority.**
18 2. **The Executive Branch of the Tohono O'odham Nation shall continue to be**
19 **responsible for the management of funds received in support of Water Project**
20 **Office activities from the Bureau of Reclamation and the Nation until such time**
21 **as the grant obligations are fully performed.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH.**
23 **Day of JUNE, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,993.7 FOR; 171.8**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 2 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


