4		Nation's savings to distribute the per capita monies (\$2,000) to the members of the
5	<b>.</b>	Tohono O'odham Nation; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Baboquivari District Council realizes that there are other priorities for the year
7		2000, but not every single member of the Tohono O'odham Nation benefits directly
8		from these priorities and programs; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has passed the Economic Development
10		Plan for the Tohono O'odham Nation and signed by the Vice-Chairman of the Nation
11		on January 05, 2000 authorizing the Economic Plan to be put in place, therefore the
12		second per capita monies should be distributed to the Nation's members as stated
13		by the Initiative 01-97 for the Tohono O'odham people and which is long over due.
14	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
15		support the second per capita distribution as stated in the Initiative 01-97 to the
16		Tohono O'odham Nation members.
