

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2001 Women, Infants & Children (WIC) Program Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-288

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for women, infants**
2 **and children during fiscal year 2000; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States**
4 **Department of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit women, infants and**
5 **children; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with**
7 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and**
8 **Children (WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 1997 through September**
9 **30, 2001; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue**
11 **to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of**
12 **individuals at risk.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 14 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-**
15 **Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible**
16 **women, infants and children.**
- 17 **2. The Memorandum of Agreement shall continue through September 30, 2001.**
- 18 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman**
19 **and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this**
20 **contract associated with this program and to expend funds when received.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH.**
23 **Day of JUNE, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,005.5 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
25 **by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


