

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(FY 2001 Food Distribution Program - Budget Proposal)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-289**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Food Distribution Program**  
2                   **under an FY 2000 Grant with the United States Department of Agriculture; and**  
3   **WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham**  
4                   **Nation and its people; and**  
5   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to renew for provision for services; and**  
6   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY**  
7                   **2001 Food Distribution Program proposal and budget.**

8   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize**  
9                   **and request the United States Department of Agriculture to renew with the Tohono**  
10                  **O'odham Nation for provision of services titled: Food Distribution Program.**

11   **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall be from October 01, 2000 and as**  
12                  **long as there is funding for the Food Distribution Program.**

13   **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
14                  **Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are**  
15                  **still being conducted and no executed grant has been approved by the United States**  
16                  **Department of Agriculture.**

17   **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
18                  **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official**  
19                  **are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that**  
20                  **any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be**  
21                  **submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

22   **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 19TH.**  
23   **Day of JUNE, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,005.5 FOR; -0-**  
24   **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
25   **by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
26   **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
27   **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
28   **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
