9		and request the United States Department of Agriculture to renew with the Tohono
10		O'odham Nation for provision of services titled: Food Distribution Program.
11	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall be from October 01, 2000 and as
12		long as there is funding for the Food Distribution Program.
13	BEITFURT	HER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
14		Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are
15		still being conducted and no executed grant has been approved by the United States
16		Department of Agriculture.
17	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
18		Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official
19		are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that
20		any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be
21		submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
