

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving request for continuation of Baboquivari District Supplement Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-294

1 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District distributed the \$500,000.00 to the six communities and**
2 **Administration, in the amount of \$75,000.00 for each community and \$50,000.00 for**
3 **Administration for home improvements and renovations; and**

4 **WHEREAS, presently some of the projects have not been completed within the communities, the**
5 **six communities all agreed that there is a need to extend the deadline in order to**
6 **complete these home improvement and renovation projects; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council by Resolution No. 00-B-33 has amended Resolution**
8 **No. 00-B-01 to extend its Supplemental Budget extension.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves Baboquivari**
10 **District's request to extend its Supplement Budget deadline from June 30, 2000 to**
11 **December 31, 2000 in order to complete the home improvements and renovation**
12 **projects.**

14 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 23rd day**
15 **of JUNE 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,624.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
16 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 540.7 [12] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
17 **1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
18 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
19 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
20 **Stat. 984).**


- WHEREAS, The Baboquivari District Council met on June 10,2000 and discussed the \$500,000.00 Supplemental deadline extension,and ;
