

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of Budget Modification #2 for the Office of the Prosecutor)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-301

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is fully authorized to act on behalf of our members in  
2 matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, as  
3 amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. seq., (hereinafter the Act); and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered to act for and on behalf of its  
5 Tohono O'odham Members in adopting resolutions; and

6 WHEREAS, the Office of the Prosecutor has submitted Budget Modification #2 for approval by the  
7 Legislative Council; and

8 WHEREAS, the Office of the Prosecutor has a need to reallocate funds within its FY 2000 budget;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, funds from line items 610 (Salaries) and 857 (Payments to Victims and Witnesses) will  
11 be reallocated to line item 750 (Capital); and

12 WHEREAS, the Office of the Prosecutor does not currently have line item 750 (Capital) in its FY  
13 2000 budget; and

14 WHEREAS, this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as this resolution has been fully  
15 completed, expressly rescinded or modified by the Legislative Council.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby  
17 establishes line item 750 (Capital) for the FY 2000 budget of the Office of the  
18 Prosecutor and approves as attached Budget Modification #2.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10<sup>TH</sup> Day  
20 of JULY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
21 -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(3)  
22 of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
23 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
24 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
