2		Second Revenue Allocation Plan (RAP) and a Second Initiative Funding and
3		Implementation Plan for Per Capita Payments (FIP); and
4	WHEREAS,	in adopting the RAP and FIP the Council authorized a set aside of \$2.7 million for
5		administrative costs during fiscal year 2001; and
6	WHEREAS,	by letter dated June 23, 2000 the Western Regional Director of the Bureau of Indian
7		Affairs forwarded its recommendation of a favorable review of the Nation's RAP and
8		FIP to the Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and
9	WHEREAS,	the expedited review process by BIA necessitates that the Nation begin its
10		implementation prior to fiscal year 2001; and
11	WHEREAS,	the  Executive  Branch  did  prepare  and  present  to  the  Budget  and  Finance  Committee  the  Commi
12		budgets for the Accounting Department (\$88,236.42) and the Enrollment Office
13		(\$72,847.95) reflecting the projected costs of immediate implementation of the Per
14		Capita Payment work during the current fiscal year; and
15	WHEREAS,	it is the recommendation of the Executive Branch and the Committee to fund these
16		budgets, attached and incorporated into this resolution, from the established
17		administrative fund set aside under Resolution No. 2000-269.
18	NOW, THER	${f EFORE}, {f BEITRESOLVED}$ by the ${f TohonoO'odhamLegislativeCouncil}$ that it does hereby
19		approve the attached budgets for the Accounting Department, in the amount of
20		\$88,236.42, and the Enrollment Office, in the amount of \$72,847.95, for purposes of
21		immediate implementation work of the Second Per Capita Payment.
