

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Fiscal Year 2000 Individuals with Disabilities Education Act Budget Modification #1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-323

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the IDEA Program for
2 numerous years; and

3 WHEREAS, the IDEA Program provides services to special needs children birth through five years
4 of age, on the Reservation and surrounding areas; and

5 WHEREAS, as a result of in-house modification, involving pass through line item 810, reflecting
6 Indirect Cost has increased to \$2,523.85, changing the total budget amount of
7 \$17,983.85 to \$18,723.85; and

8 WHEREAS, the FY 2000 allocation direct funds in the amount of \$16,200.00, is not effected and
9 remains as is.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes
11 the IDEA Budget Modification #1, reflecting increase of \$850.00 in Indirect Cost.

12 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the IDEA Program Budget of \$17,873.85 be changed to \$18,723.85.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day
14 of JULY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
15 -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
16 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
17 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
18 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


