

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Bureau of Indian Affairs 638 funding and authorization of
expenditure in accordance with the attached budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-324

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation acquired 638 funding through the Bureau of Indian**
2 **Affairs in the amount of \$17,500.00; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the 638 funding will be utilized for the Nation's Underground Storage Tanks (USTs)**
4 **to meet the 1998 federal compliance regulations established by the United States**
5 **Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA); and**

6 **WHEREAS, to meet the UST compliance regulations, the Tohono O'odham Nation Environmental**
7 **Office will develop environmental assessments. The environmental assessment will**
8 **include and not limited to site investigations, collection of environmental media and**
9 **submission of samples to a certified analytical laboratory; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the 638 funding will also be utilized to address any other environmental concerns**
11 **that may impact the Nation's lands or the well being of its members.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
13 **approves the Bureau of Indian Affairs 638 funding.**

14 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Council approves the attached budget and authorizes**
15 **the expenditure of the Bureau of Indian Affairs 638 funds.**

16 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day**
17 **of JULY, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
18 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
19 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
20 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
21 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
