

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2000 Budget Modification #2 Request for the Tohono O'odham
Nation Fire Department/Wildland Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-351

1 **WHEREAS, the Fire Department/Department of Public Safety has taken over operations of the**
2 **Wildland Program from Bureau of Indian Affairs and will continue to operate the**
3 **program indefinitely; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department & Wildland Program have come before**
5 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and requested approval of a budget**
6 **modification #2 for additional funding allotted to the Wildland Program under the**
7 **Wildland Fire Management Preparedness Program from Contract Modification No. 59,**
8 **approved on February 01, 2000 in the amount of \$62,400.00; and**

9 **WHEREAS, money received from the Wildland Fire Management Preparedness Program be**
10 **distributed into the all Wildland FY 2000 Budget line items; and**

11 **WHEREAS, funding has been provided by BIA Wildland PL-93-638 cost Contract for the operation**
12 **of the Wildland Program; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this funding is to be utilized to provide emergency services in the saving of lives,**
14 **property, and protection of natural resources and wildlife to the members of the**
15 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Fire Department/Department of Public Safety requests approval of funding of**
17 **Wildland Program PL-93-638 FY 2000 Budget Modification #2; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the budget is to be utilized to place the Wildland Program in Operation and for the**
19 **management of the daily operational expenses; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the request of approved Budget Modification #2 has been reviewed by the appropriate**
21 **Committees.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recommends**
23 **the approval of the Budget Modification #2 in the additional total amount of**
24 **\$62,400.00.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH, Day**
27 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
28 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
32 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


