

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Re-application of Department of Human Services/Division of Child Welfare Services - FY 2001 Title IV-B Child Welfare Service Subpart 1 and Promoting Safe and Stable Families, Subpart 2, Social Security Act)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-357

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has always had a desire to provide for the health and**
2 **welfare needs of O'odham children and families; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services/Child Welfare Services has the**
4 **primary responsibility to provide for those families found to be in the need of such**
5 **care; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Title IV-B, Subpart 1 and Subpart 2 of the Social Security Act provides funds for**
7 **development of a five year plan for demonstrating effective prevention approaches**
8 **for handling increasing family problems/dysfunction under specified terms and**
9 **conditions; and**

10 **WHEREAS, in FY 2000 a five year plan was submitted by the Human Services/Child Welfare**
11 **Division and the second year budget covering from October 01, 2000 to September 30,**
12 **2001 is hereby submitted for review and approval; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Title IV-B, Subpart 1 and Subpart 2 requires yearly re-application for funds to**
14 **support the five year plan.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 16 **1. It does approve the FY 2001 Title IV-B application funding in the amount of**
17 **\$45,698.00 for Subpart 1, and \$41,298.00 for Subpart 2.**
- 18 **2. That the budget period is FY 01 (October 01, 2000 to September 30, 2001).**
- 19 **3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice**
20 **Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and**
21 **execute the grant.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08th Day**
23 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
25 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**


