


**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 2001 Water Resources Program Budget Justification - Continuation of the
USGS Border Study)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-359

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Water Resources Study**
2 **Program under a P.L. 93-638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**
3 **WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham**
4 **Nation; and**
5 **WHEREAS, an amount of \$113,778.00 is allocated for the United States Geological Survey**
6 **Cooperative Border Study; and**
7 **WHEREAS, authorization was requested and granted to enter into a joint funding agreement**
8 **between the U.S. Geological Survey and the Water Resources Study Program of the**
9 **Tohono O'odham Nation to conduct a hydrological investigation along the portion of**
10 **the Southern boundary of the Nation and \$113,778.00 is to fund this cooperative**
11 **agreement; and**
12 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program does submit for review and approval of the**
13 **Budget Justification reflecting the amount of \$113,778.00; and**
14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 2001 Water Resources Study**
15 **Program budget; and**
16 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council-Water Resources Committee has reviewed**
17 **and approved the FY 2001 US Geological Survey budget.**
18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize**
19 **expenditures per attached budget for the implementation of the Water Resource Study**
20 **Program.**
21 **BE FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nations Official's to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are**
23 **hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Contract, provided however, that any**
24 **amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted**
25 **for further prior approval by this Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
28 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**


