

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In Support of Higher Education Services FY - 2000 Budget Modification #3 Acct. 10-1215)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-363

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, through the Higher Education Services program has**
2 **successfully provided counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post-Secondary Institute; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services in-house modification, moving funds within the**
5 **budget, with the total amount reflecting the Indirect Cost to be decreased from**
6 **\$10,178.24 to \$8,986.03.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes**
8 **the Higher Education Services Budget Modification #3, reflecting a decrease of**
9 **\$1,192.21 in Indirect Cost.**

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Higher Education Services budget of \$854,578.69 has**
11 **decreased to \$853,386.48 for FY - 2000.**


12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09th Day**
13 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
14 **AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
18 **Stat. 984).**
