

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(To Reject the Chairman's Proposal to make Improvements to the Sells Trailer Park and to Support the Sells District Council's Decision to Close the Trailer Park)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-370**

1 **WHEREAS, during the August 09, 2000 General Session, the Chairman of the Nation did present**  
2 **an update regarding the Sells Trailer Park for consideration by the Council; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Council heard the update and discussion regarding the Chairman's**  
4 **interpretation that the Nation is responsible for the Trailer Park based on an expired**  
5 **lease; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Chairman's intent is to utilize the Nation's financial and program resources to**  
7 **correct the health deficiencies for the benefit of the residents and therefore allow the**  
8 **residents to remain.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council rejects the**  
10 **Chairman's proposal to utilize the Nation's financial and program resources to**  
11 **correct the health deficiencies for the benefit of the residents and therefore allow the**  
12 **residents to remain.**

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council supports the Sells District Council's**  
14 **decision to close the Trailer Park.**

15 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**  
16 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,275.25 FOR; 350.70**  
17 **AGAINST; 406.15 NOT VOTING; and 133.4 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
18 **by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
19 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
20 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
21 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


