

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Endorsement for the Candidacy of Eva Carrillo Dong for Pima County  
School Superintendent)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-372

1 WHEREAS, during the August 10, 2000 General Session, Eva Carrillo Dong did appear before the  
2 Legislative Council to seek the Nation's endorsement for her candidacy for Pima  
3 County School Superintendent; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the issues and concerns addressed by Eva  
5 Carrillo Dong with regard to education.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation hereby supports and  
7 approves the endorsement for the candidacy of Eva Carrillo Dong for Pima County  
8 School Superintendent.

9 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. Day  
10 of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,697.95 FOR; -0-  
11 AGAINST; 79.05 NOT VOTING; and 388.5 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
12 by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
13 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
14 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
15 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
