6	WHEREAS.	Mr. Leonard Peltier has never had a fair trial that would enable him to prove his

8	WHEREAS.	more recently on June 12, 2000, Mr. Leonard Peltier was again denied parole, despite			
9	,	numerous documentation and retracted statements made by U.S. attorneys that			
10		could and should exonerate Mr. Leonard Peltier; and

11	WHEREAS,	Mr. Leonard Peltier, a Native American from the Turtle Mountain Reservation of the			
12		state of North Dakota has gained wide international support from many well known			
13		and respected citizens and governments of the world, calling for his immediate and			
14		unconditional release.			
15	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:			
16		1. That the Tohono O'odham Nation again respectfully requests the U.S.			
17		Government, President William Jefferson Clinton to exonerate Mr. Leonard			
18		Peltier with Executive Clemency and release him immediately.			
19		2. That U.S. Attorney General Janet Reno conduct a full investigation into the ethics			
20		complaint filed June 26, 2000 by Mr. Leonard Peltier through his attorneys with			
21		regard to his case.
