

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Acceptance and Use of the Technical Assistance Grant of the Native American Library Services, Institute of Museum and Library Services in the Fiscal Year 2001 by the Venito Garcia Library)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-374

1 **WHEREAS, Native Library Services, a division of the Institute of Museum and Library Services of**
2 **the U.S. Federal Government, is providing funding to Federally recognized native**
3 **nations for technical consultation on a non-competitive basis; and**

4 **WHEREAS, these funds are available to the Venito Garcia Library, the library agency of the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Education Department, for technical consultation on a non-**
6 **competitive basis; and**

7 **WHEREAS, there is currently no funding for technical assistance for the Venito Garcia Library;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, a request for waiver of indirect costs is a condition for the Native American Library**
10 **Services Technical Assistance Grant.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby finds**
12 **this Technical Assistance Grant in the best interests of the Venito Garcia Library and**
13 **therefore supports the Library's grant application to the Native American Library**
14 **Services for a Technical Assistance Grant in the amount of \$2000.00, they hereby**
15 **accept the Technical Assistance Grant and authorize the Librarian of the Venito**
16 **Garcia Library to use these available funds to enhance library programs of the**
17 **Tohono O'odham Nation.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and**
19 **hereby waives indirect cost, which is a condition on the funds of the Native American**
20 **Library Services Basic Grant made by the granting agency.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10th. Day**
23 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,777.0 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 388.5 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
