

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Acceptance and Use of the Basic Grant of the Native American Library Services,
Institute of Museum and Library Services in the Fiscal Year 2001 by the Venito Garcia Library)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-375

1 **WHEREAS, Native Library Services (a division of the Institute of Museum and Library Services of**
2 **the U.S. Federal Government) is the primary funding agency for tribal libraries for**
3 **Federally recognized native nations, and is making available a Basic Grant to each**
4 **recognized nation on a non-competitive basis for basic library services and**
5 **materials; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically supported the Venito Garcia Library as**
7 **the library agency of the Tohono O'odham Education Department; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there is currently no funding for library materials and library-related supplies**
9 **available to the Venito Garcia Library; and**

10 **WHEREAS, a request for waiver of indirect costs is a condition for the Native American Library**
11 **Services Basic Grant.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports**
13 **the Venito Garcia Library's Basic Grant application to the Native American Library**
14 **Services for the amount of \$4,000.00, authorizing the Librarian of the Venito Garcia**
15 **Library on behalf of the Venito Garcia Library to buy library materials and library-**
16 **related supplies for the Library's programs.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and**
18 **hereby waives indirect cost, which is a condition on the funds of the Native American**
19 **Library Services Basic Grant made by the granting agency.**

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21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10th. Day**
22 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,777.0 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 388.5 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
25 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
26 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
27 **Stat. 984).**
