

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing the Demolition and Hazardous Waste Clean-Up of the Old Tribal Building  
and Authorizing the Chairman of the Nation to Contract for such Services)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-379**

1 **WHEREAS, the old tribal building has deteriorated beyond economical repair and has recently**  
2 **been subject to severe fire damage; and**

3 **WHEREAS, test results have determined that the building contains high levels of asbestos and**  
4 **lead paint; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the old tribal building is a public health and safety nuisance; and**

6 **WHEREAS, four options for clean-up have been reviewed and cost estimates received from two**  
7 **qualified vendors for all options; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Environmental Trust Fund has been established to fund hazardous waste clean-**  
9 **ups; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety has been granted authority to expend funds from the**  
11 **Environmental Trust Fund by Resolution No. 2000-194.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that:**

13 **1. The old tribal building shall be demolished and construction debris and**  
14 **hazardous waste disposed of in accordance with tribal law; and**

15 **2. The Chairman of the Nation or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and**  
16 **execute any and all agreements necessary for the demolition and clean-up of the**  
17 **old tribal building; and**

18 **3. The costs of the demolition and clean-up shall not exceed \$100,000.00 and will be**  
19 **funded from the Environmental Trust Fund.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH. Day**  
21 **of AUGUST, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,812.15 FOR; 130.75**  
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Section 1 (c)(2), (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**  
24 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
