7		utilizing their Central Arizona Project water allocation and in asserting their water
8		right claims; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Reclamation in the Department of the Interior has funds available in
10		FY 2000 to assist the Nation in performing this necessary irrigation feasibility study

13	WHEREAS,	the Nation intends to subcontract the irrigation feasibility study to the consultant
14		who is the Nation's subcontractor under the Gila~River~Adjudication~Program; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee have
16		reviewed and approved this resolution.
17	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nation approves the Cooperative Agreement with
