3	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has through its Tribal Constitution always recognized				
4		Tribal Membership based on O'odham Blood Quantum; and				
5	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has membership residing in traditional land located in				
6		Mexico; and				
7	WHEREAS,	the United States-Mexico Border Health Commission Act, Public Law 103-400				
8		authorizes health assessment of the United States-Mexico border areas in identifying,				
9		preventing, evaluating and resolving health problems among the residents in border				
10		areas, including tribal lands; and				
11	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham has a keen interest in addressing the health needs of the				
12		O'odham in Mexico.				
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:					
14		1. The Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation requests that the National				
15		Indian Health Board consult and work with the appointed Border Health				
16		Commissioners to create congressional action to assist in resolving the health				
17		care needs of the O'odham in Mexico.				
18		2. The Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation requests for the National				
19		Indian Health Board to direct the appointed Border Health Commissioners in				
20		supporting development of health programs to meet the needs of border tribes.
