1WHEREAS,the Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA") has proposed new regulations at 25 CFR Part 702which will establish the documentation requirements and standards for issuing a3Certificate of Degree of Indian or Alaska Native Blood by the BIA; and4WHEREAS,these regulations will allow the BIA to provide a Certificate of Degree of Indian or5Alaska Native Blood to individuals who are not enrolled members of any federally6recognized tribe but whose combined Indian blood from ancestors who are enrolled7members of Indian tribes exceeds 50%; and8WHEREAS,these regulations will allow individuals who have a BIA issued Certificate of Degree9of Indian or Alaska Native Blood but are not enrolled in any tribe to receive federal10services from the Indian Health Service and the Bureau of Indian Affairs, thereby11diluting the provision of federal services to enrolled tribal members; and12WHEREAS,the limited resources of the Indian Health Service and the Bureau of Indian Affairs13are already spread too thin and result in an inadequate level of services to enrolled14Tohono O'odham tribal members; and

15 WHEREAS, the Rules Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the						
16 proposed BIA regulations and recommends that the Nation oppose these regulations						
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation opposes the new BIA						
18 regulations at 25 CFR Part 70 because they will result in the dilution of federal						
19 services to enrolled Tohono O'odham tribal members who are already receiving an						
20 inadequate level of service from the Indian Health Service and the Bureau of Indian						
21 Affairs.						
22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized and						
23 directed to communicate the Nation's opposition to the Bureau of Indian Affairs or						
24 or before the comment deadline of August 16, 2000.
