

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Providing Authority to Tohono O'odham Community College to Enter into
Self-Determination Contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-412

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ('Nation') has chartered the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Community College ('TOCC') by a Charter adopted by Resolution No. 98-006; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the TOCC is a "tribal organization" as defined by Public Law 93-638, the Indian Self-**
4 **Determination and Education Assistance Act, at 25 U.S.C. § 450b(1), because it is a**
5 **legally established organization of Indians which is controlled, sanctioned, or**
6 **chartered by the governing body of the Nation, and TOCC is therefore authorized by**
7 **P.L. 93-638 to enter into Self-Determination Contracts when the contract is requested**
8 **by an Indian tribe; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the TOCC has requested that the Nation provide authority to TOCC to enter into its**
10 **own Self-Determination Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to obtain future**
11 **federal funding; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Nation intends that 638 contract funding designated for the Career Center in the**
13 **Nation's Master Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs hereafter be designated**
14 **for the TOCC in its own 638 Self-Determination contract, beginning on October 01,**
15 **2000; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the HRDC and Budget & Finance Committees of the Legislative Council have reviewed**
17 **this proposal and recommend approval by the full Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation:**

- 19 **1. Authorizes the TOCC to enter into a Self-Determination Contract with the Bureau**
20 **of Indian Affairs, delegates all authority necessary to TOCC to enable it to contract**
21 **with the BIA, and requests that the Secretary of the Interior enter into such a Self-**
22 **Determination Contract with TOCC; and**
- 23 **2. Authorizes the TOCC to establish its own indirect cost rate with the Bureau of**
24 **Indian Affairs.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day**
26 **of SEPTEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,225.75 FOR;**
27 **372.7 AGAINST; 407.05 NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
28 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
29 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
