

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(638 Savings Carry Over; Authorization of Expenditure)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-417

1 WHEREAS, it was discovered that Law Enforcement had 638 savings totaling \$1,121,008.41 from
2 fiscal years 1996 through 2000; and

3 WHEREAS, of these savings, \$1,008,033.41 will be used to temporarily offset Law Enforcement's
4 Fiscal Year 2001 Tribal Base Appropriation; and

5 WHEREAS, the remaining \$112,975.00 of these savings will be used to serve as a 25% match for
6 the Tribal Resources Grant Program Grant.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
8 carryover of the prior fiscal years 1996-2000 unencumbered obligations, totaling
9 \$1,121,008.41.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the balances as identified by the attached budget are hereby
11 carried over.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any amount used to temporarily offset the Fiscal Year 2001 Tribal
13 Base will be returned to bring Fiscal Year 2002 Tribal Allocation back to true base.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH, Day
16 of SEPTEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,833.7 FOR; -0-
17 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 331.8 [11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
18 Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
19 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
20 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
21 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
