

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appropriating from Savings \$2,473,478 for the Second Year of Operation of the  
Tohono O'odham Community College)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-419

- 1 **WHEREAS, Resolution 98-06 approved Ordinance 98-01 enacting the Charter of the Tohono**  
2 **O'odham Community College (hereinafter "TOCC"); and**
- 3 **WHEREAS, the majority of District Councils previously approved two years of funding for TOCC**  
4 **from gaming savings; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees as part of its annual report has approved the proposed budget**  
6 **per article 4.2.5 of the College charter; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees voted approval of the Fiscal Year of the College to begin July 1<sup>st</sup>**  
8 **of each year and end June 30<sup>th</sup>; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, TOCC is preparing an environmental scan, educational masterplan, and facilities**  
10 **masterplan to determine space needs and associated costs for a permanent campus**  
11 **as well as the location in the near future but is not requesting capital funds at this**  
12 **time as was originally planned; and**
- 13 **WHEREAS, the second year budget of \$2,473,478 was identified as necessary for the operation not**  
14 **including capital expense of the TOCC for Fiscal Year 2001; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the Charter of the TOCC, under Article 4, sets forth a fiduciary duty for the TOCC**  
16 **Board by requiring that "the affairs of the TOCC shall be managed by the Board of**  
17 **Trustees" and, under Article 7, that the Board "may establish and maintain such bank**  
18 **accounts as may be necessary and convenient" within the limitations provided in the**  
19 **Charter of the TOCC.**
- 20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council fully supports**  
21 **and appropriates \$2,473,478 from the Desert Diamond savings, to be set aside in an**  
22 **interest bearing account to be maintained by the TOCC Board for those purposes of**  
23 **operating the TOCC for Fiscal Year 2001, July 01, 2000 - June 30, 2001.**
- 24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the TOCC Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to utilize any and**  
25 **all funds provided by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council in furtherance of the**  
26 **Charter.**
- 27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the TOCC Board of Trustees has authority within the parameters**  
28 **of the TOCC Charter to identify, receive and expend any and all funds in furtherance**  
29 **of the Charter, including but not limited to any funds available pursuant to P.L. 93-**

1                   **638, funds appropriated by the Tohono O'odham Nation for TOCC and any other funds**  
2                   **from any source previously identified.**

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this appropriation and the use of such funds by the TOCC Board is**  
4                   **subject to the requirements set forth under the Charter of the TOCC as enacted by**  
5                   **Ordinance 98-01 and any applicable laws of the Tohono O'odham Nation or United**  
6                   **States.**

7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH. Day**  
8 **of SEPTEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,084.8 FOR; 659.2**  
9 **AGAINST; 261.5 NOT VOTING; and 160.0 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
10 **by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
11 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
12 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
13 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


