

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting and Approving the Needs Assessment and Planning Report drafted
by the Nation's Consultant, EKM, Inc.)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-425

1 **WHEREAS, in August, 1999, the Judicial Branch and the Tohono O'odham Police Department**
2 **created a partnership for the purposes of developing and constructing a correction**
3 **facility to house both adults and juveniles; and**

4 **WHEREAS, a technical committee comprised of the Nation's Planning Department, Police**
5 **Department, Judicial Branch, and Office of the Attorney General was formed to**
6 **conduct research and planning necessary to fund and construct the joint corrections**
7 **facility; and**

8 **WHEREAS, by its February 08, 2000, Resolution No. 2000-046, the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
9 **Council appropriated funds to hire a consultant and authorized the technical**
10 **committee to work with the consultant to conduct a needs assessment and planning**
11 **of the Adult and Juvenile Joint Correction Facility; and**

12 **WHEREAS, one of the primary purposes of the completion of the needs assessment and planning**
13 **was to prepare for the next grant funding cycle of the United States Department of**
14 **Justice; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the technical committee and its consultant, EKM, Inc. have completed the needs**
16 **assessment and report and have presented the report to the Legislative Council for**
17 **its acceptance and approval. The technical committee has further requested**
18 **authorization to utilize the report in its future submission of grant applications.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**
20 **approves the needs assessment and planning report drafted by the Nation's**
21 **consultant, EKM, Inc. and authorizes the technical committee to utilize the report in**
22 **its future grant applications.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH. Day**
25 **of SEPTEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,719.0 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 446.5 [09] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) & (g) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
