

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Extension of Grant Agreement with Bureau of Reclamation under Public Law 93-638
for a Comprehensive Water Inventory)

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-435

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") entered into a Grant Agreement with the
2 United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, Phoenix Area Office
3 under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act, Public Law 93-
4 638, for the purpose of conducting a comprehensive water inventory of the Nation,
5 designated as Agreement No. 98-FG-32-00800 ("Grant Agreement"); and

6 WHEREAS, the term of the Grant Agreement was for three (3) years, beginning on October 01,
7 1997 and expiring on September 30, 2000; and

8 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation has transferred the agreed upon funds under the Grant
9 Agreement to the Nation in the amount of \$5,485,171, but the Nation has not yet
10 completed the performance of the water inventory; and

11 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Nation to extend the term of the Grant Agreement for
12 up to five (5) years to allow the Nation to complete its performance of a
13 comprehensive water inventory.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the
15 Chairman of the Nation to negotiate and execute an extension of the Grant Agreement
16 with the Bureau of Reclamation for up to five (5) years.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 22ND Day
18 of SEPTEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,993.7 FOR; -0-
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 171.8 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (c)(2), (f), (i)(1)(2) of Article VI and Section 1 (d), (f) & 2(g) of Article VII of the Constitution
21 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
22 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
23 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


