RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving 401(k) Pension Plan)

RESOLUTION NO. <u>2000-453</u>

1	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 341-90 (copy attached), the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2		Council approved the establishment of a retirement plan for employees of the
3		Tohono O'odham Nation administered through Principal Mutual, now known as The
4		Principal Financial Group (the "Principal Plan"); and
5	WHEREAS,	Section 1426(a) of the Small Business Job Protection Act of 1996, P.L. 104-188,
6		extended eligibility to Indian nations to adopt pension plans under Section 401(k) of
7		the Internal Revenue Code ("401(k) Plan"); and
8	WHEREAS,	an ad hoc Pension Committee was established to assess whether to recommend a
9		401(k) Plan for the Nation; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Pension Committee includes representatives of the Executive, Legislative and
11		Judicial Branches; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Pension Committee has concluded its assessment of a 401(k) Plan, and has
13		determined that such a Plan is significantly more beneficial to the Nation's
14		employees than the Principal Plan and serves the interests of the Nation in the
15		recruitment and retention of employees; and
16	WHEREAS,	in the form attached, the key documents required to implement a 401(k) Plan have
17		been prepared and reviewed by the Pension Committee, namely (1) the Tohono
18		O'odham Nation 401(k) Retirement Plan Trust Agreement between the Nation and the
19		Trustees (the "Trust Agreement") under which one representative from each Branch
20		of the Nation's government will be designated by the head of such Branch to serve as
21		a Trustee; (2) the Tohono O'odham Nation 401(k) Retirement Plan (the "Nation's
22		401(k) Plan"), accompanied by a summary of such Plan; and (3) a Group Annuity
23		Contract between ReliaStar Life Insurance Company ("ReliaStar") and the Trustees
24		of the Nation's 401(k) Plan (the "Annuity Contract"); and
25	WHEREAS,	the attached (1) Amendment Ceasing Future Contributions to the Tohono O'odham
26		Nation Money Purchase Pension Plan, currently being administered by Principal (the
27		"Principal Plan Amendment"), and (2) the Notice of Significant Reduction in Benefit
28		Accruals under the Principal Plan (the "Employee Notice") are required to ensure the
29		timely transfer of accounts under the Principal Plan to the Nation's 401(k) Plan and

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1		to avoid any gaps in the Nation's contributions under the Principal Plan and the
2		Nation's 401(k) Plan; and
3	WHEREAS,	certain other documents are required to be completed or executed by the Nation to
4		implement the Nation's 401(k) Plan, including a Record keeping Services Agreement,
5		and Internet Services Addendum, between ReliaStar and the Nation (the
6		"Recordkeeping Agreement") (ReliaStar form attached).
7	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
8		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the Trust Agreement,
9		the Nation's 401(k) Plan and the Annuity Contract.
10		2. The Legislative Council approves the Employee Notice.
11		3. The Legislative Council approves the Principal Plan Amendment, effective on the
12		last day of the payroll period ending prior to the "Initial Entry Date" (as those
13		terms are defined in the Nation's 401(k) Plan) which shall be a date no earlier
14		than 15 days after the date of the Employee Notice.
15		4. The Legislative Council authorizes the Chairman of the Nation, the Chairman of
16		the Legislative Council and the Chief Judge of the Judicial Branch to each
17		designate one Trustee (collectively the "Trustees").
18		5. The Trustees and the Chairman of the Nation are authorized to execute the Trust
19		Agreement and such other documents as may be required to implement the
20		Agreement.
21		6. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to execute the Nation's 401(k) Plan and
22		such other documents as may be required to implement the Plan.
23		7. The Trustees are authorized to execute the Annuity Contract and such other
24		documents as may be required to implement the Contract.
25		8. The Chairman is authorized to issue the Employee Notice.
26		9. The Chairman is authorized to execute the Principal Plan Amendment and such
27		other documents as may be necessary to maintain the Principal Plan as a frozen
28		plan until the assets in the Principal Plan accounts can be transferred into, and
29		made a part of, the Nation's 401(k) Plan, subject to timing restrictions as may be
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1	advised for Internal Revenue Service compliance or for completion of proper
2	recordkeeping procedures, after which the Nation's 401(k) Plan shall be the sole
3	surviving retirement plan of the Nation.
4	10. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to negotiate and execute the
5	Recordkeeping Agreement and such documents as may be required to
6	implement the Agreement.
7	11. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to cause the submission of the 401(k)
8	Plan and related documents to the Internal Revenue Service for approval.
9 10	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>28TH.</u> Day of <u>SEPTEMBER, 2000</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,165.5</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u>
11	AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
12 13	Section 1 <u>(d)(2)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
13	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
15	18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
