

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Continuing Funds Available Under Resolution 99-585 Through Fiscal Year 2001)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2000-467**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 99-585 for an**  
2 **intergovernmental and public relations strategy to advance the interests of the**  
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation in Fiscal Year 2000; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the critical efforts initiated under Resolution No. 99-585 remain ongoing and need**  
5 **to be continued through Fiscal Year 2001.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that funds available under Resolution 99-585 continue**  
7 **through Fiscal Year 2001 for the purposes and efforts therein specified until such**  
8 **time as the funds are expended.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 28TH, Day**  
10 **of SEPTEMBER, 2000 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,399.9 FOR; 660.8**  
11 **AGAINST; 104.8 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
12 **Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
13 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
14 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
15 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




