T	WHEREAS,	the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978, Public Law 95-608, 25 U.S.C. § 1901 <u>et seq</u> . (the
2		$\hbox{\it ``Act'''), was enacted to establish minimum federal standards for the removal of Indian}$
3		children from their families and the placement of such children in foster or adoptive
4		homes which will reflect the unique values of Indian culture; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Act provides the Indian child's tribe certain rights with respect to state court
6		proceedings involving Indian children, as well as certain rights with respect to the
7		placement of Indian children in adoptive, foster, or pre-adoptive homes; and
8	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 230-84, the Papago Human Services Department (now known as the
9		Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services) was designated as the agency of the
10		Nation to discharge the solemn responsibilities placed upon the Nation by the Act and
11		delegated all necessary authority to meet the responsibilities arising under the act;
12		and
13	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 96-020 the Attorney General of the Tohono O'odham Nation was
14		designated the agent for service of notice required under the act; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General received notice of a juvenile proceeding in Franklin County,
16		Missouri, involving a child who is an enrolled member of the Nation; and
17	WHEREAS,	Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services recommends intervention in the
18		Franklin County Juvenile proceedings so that the Nation's rights and interests under
19		the Act may be adequately represented; and
20	WHEREAS,	it is necessary to retain legal representation in the State of Missouri to provide legal
21		advice and representation to the Nation with respect to the proceedings arising
22		under the Indian Child Welfare Act; and
23	WHEREAS,	the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for Fiscal Year 2001, as
24		approved by the Legislative Council, has sufficient funds for an attorney contract in
25		the amount of \$5,000.00 for representation in these proceedings; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with Buescher & Franke,
27		L.L.C., in the amount of \$5,000.00, a copy of which is attached hereto.
